	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. EDB announces that classes will be suspended, but the school will remain open to cater for children who need to return to school 2. All outdoor activities will be cancelled when the Red Rainstorm or Typhoon Signal No. 3 is in force 3. For other signals, appropriate measures will be taken depending on the location of the activity
	
 	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. The school will continue as usual 2. As the Observatory will issue the “Landslip” and “Thunderstorm Signal” on a regional basis, staff should pay attention to the weather conditions at outdoor activity areas 3. If outing activities are held indoors, e.g. visiting museums, staff can make flexible adjustments according to the location of the activity
